- **AUDIT/NO CREDIT** grades are not accepted by the VA and **WILL** result in overpayment and result in a reduction of VA education benefit for that term.
- _____ NON-PROCESSING grade is a grade that is not better than previously received MAY result in an overpayment.
- A **ONE-TIME** exclusion MAY be granted to a student by the VA when they have dropped up to six (6) credit hours after the school drop date. This applies to any previous school where VA benefits have been used.
