- _____ Student declaring **UNDECIDED/NON-DEGREE** may only receive education benefits for the first two semesters. Certification for UNDECIDED students will be for Core Requirements only. Courses for GRADUATE students must be toward program, if waiting to be accepted.

_____ **VA COMPLIANCE AUDITS:** If it is discovered that a student receives benefits they are not entitled an overpayment will be issued for which the student is liable.

GRADES AND SCHEDULE CHANGES:

_____ If you make any changes to your class schedule, you **MUST** bring your new Concise Schedule to the VMRC office for verification to prevent possible overpayment.

_____ **AUDIT/NO CREDIT** grades are not accepted by the VA and **WILL** result in overpayment and result in a reduction of VA education benefit for that term.

_____ **NON-PROCESSING** grade is a grade that is not better than previously received **MAY** result in an overpayment.

_____ A **ONE-TIME** exclusion MAY be granted to a student by the VA when they have dropped up to six (6) credit hours after the school drop date. This applies to any previous school where VA benefits have been used.
